Vanguard Key Club – YORK "De-activated" until further notice per Governor Mills

Due to the recent developments related to COVID-19, we received notification from the State of Maine to cease access to this location **beginning at Midnight March 24th**. We had hoped to receive some relief to be considered an "essential business" however; the State has made it clear that they will be enforcing this action.

This decision comes with great difficulty as our belief in the need for people to continue their fitness routines in order to help fight off illness and relieve stress and anxiety during this time is paramount and even "essential". Our operational model allows these activities in small groups that could provide safe "social distancing" methods without the requirement of staff, however, as the previously recommended gatherings of even 10 people or less were generally within our normal usage history, we have been forced to follow through with the State mandate.

<u>Currently this order will last only 2 weeks until April 8th</u> and because all active Vanguard Key Club members are part of a network of facilities, <u>you currently have access to our other locations so that you may continue your routines.</u> We understand this may not be convenient for the foreseeable future and we cannot guarantee that those other locations will remain accessible during this crisis; so you have the option, as always, to freeze your account until such time you are allowed to return to your normal routines at this location.

We are deeply sorry for this change in events. We, probably more than any other gym or health club, were uniquely situated to avoid this type of shut down; however, the restrictions placed on us all by the Governor, "in an abundance of caution" has given us no other practical choice. As inconvenient as the previous limits were on many facilities in our industry, it still provided a choice and an outlet for people to live a healthy lifestyle during a very difficult time. We at Vanguard Key Clubs do not entirely agree with the decision to shutter any facility that promotes health, we do not consider our industry as "recreational", but we respect the severity of the time and for the time being, we will reinforce our efforts at our other locations and welcome you there for as long as we are allowed.
